Over the last four weeks, we have seen Jesus make as many “I Am” claims to be God. He began in John Chapter 6 with the statement:

**-I Am the Bread of Life.**

Here, Jesus claims to be the Sustenance for everlasting Life. Next, in Chapter 8, He said:

- **I Am the Light of the World.** Here, He claims to be the Light that expels darkness for those who follow Him. In Chapter 10, we get the next two “I Am” statements. First:
- **I Am the Gate for the Sheep.** Here, Jesus shows that anyone who enters the sheep pen without coming through the Gate is a thief. Second:
- **I Am the Good Shepherd.** Last week, we saw that Jesus showed the difference between Himself and the hired hands who “cared nothing for the sheep.”

Today, on Resurrection Day, we will look at Jesus’ fifth “I Am” statement: **I Am the Resurrection and the Life. We see this in Chapter 11.** I hope we will understand the gravity of each of Jesus’ statements as we seek to worship Him today. The title of our message today is: **I Am the Good Shepherd.**
