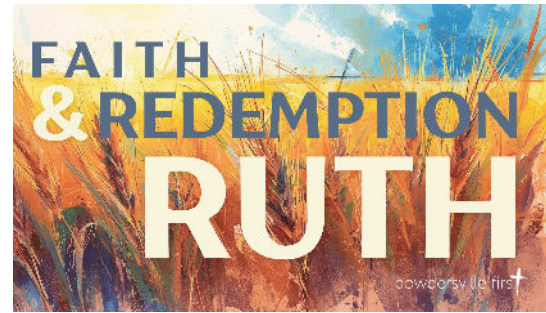
- 1 - Introduction to Ruth
