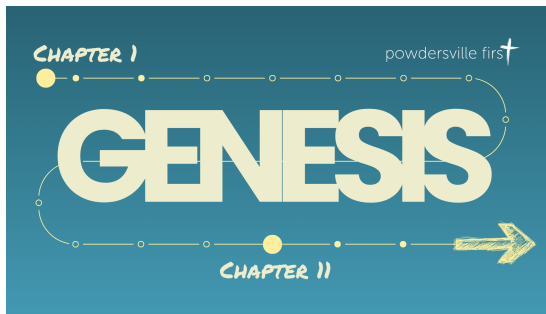




August 23, 2026

Last week, we looked at a sad section of Scripture: **Genesis 6:1-7**. Our sermon title was: **A Grieved God**, and we talked about how the sin of Adam back in **Genesis 3**

had multiplied. This sin was described in **Verse 5**: *The Lord saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time*. The result of the sin is given in **Verse 6**: *The Lord was grieved that he had made man on the earth, and his heart was filled with pain*.

That which God had created in His image and for His glory had turned on Him. In the Book of **John**, we see a similar reaction to Jesus. **John 1:10-11** *He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. [11] He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him*.

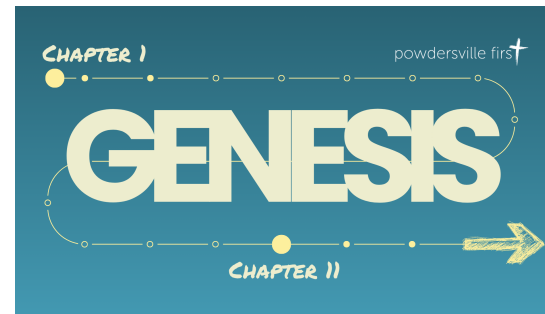
