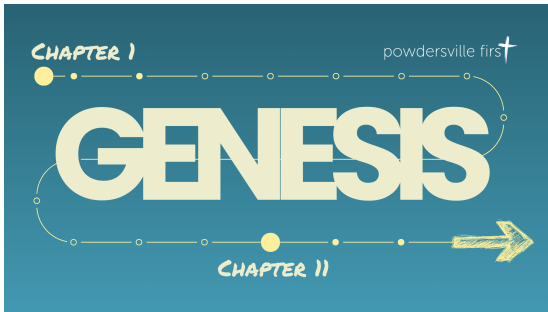

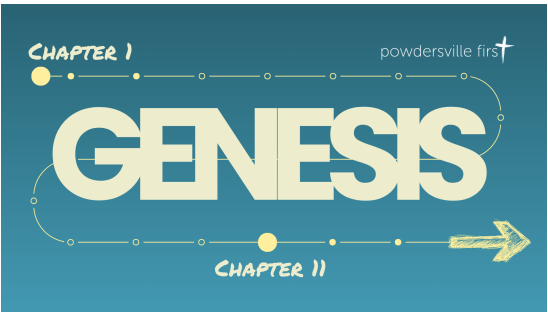
Our message will come from **Genesis 7:1-24**, and our message is titled **God’s Redemptive Judgment**. Our points will be:
